

HOW TO GET TO POZNAŃ:

By plane:

Direct flights to Poznań-Ławica Airport (POZ):

Other airports with relatively good railway connection to Poznań:

*) direct bus connections from the airport to Poznań Main Station (Poznań Główny)

By ferry:

From Sweden:

- Malmo**, Treleborg**, **Ystad** to Świnoujście,

- Nynäshamn to Gdańsk

- Karlskrona to Gdynia

then by train or car. **Beware, some connections available for drivers and passengers in cars only!

By train:

Beware, there are several railway companies and train types, check your ticket before travel.

Perhaps you'll be able to find more connections from other companies (like Czech RegioJet), they are not indicated at the PKP timetables!

All intercity trains will bring you to the **Poznań Główny (Main Station)**.

If you find a train stopping at Poznań-Garbarzy station, you'll have just 10 minutes of nice walk to the "Vivaldi" hotel!

Direct connections from bigger cities in neighbouring countries:

Berlin Gesundbrunnen/Berlin Lichtenberg

Berlin Hauptbahnhof (D):

Approx. every 2 hrs between 5 AM and 9 PM CET(CEST), no night trains! Beware, periodical bus backup connection from Berlin Hbf to Frankfurt /Oder

Praha hl.n. (CZ)

Four direct connections a day

Mockava (LT) – connection from **Vilnius** by LTG Link

Wien Westbahnhof (A) (15:33)

By bus:

You'll find plenty of connections to Poznań Główny bus station, by FlixBus, mainly. Consider all advantages and disadvantages

By car:

From North-West S3 express road/A2 highway(with fee) or S3/ DK24/92 from Skwierzyna (same time, closer distance, no fees)

North: A1/A2 highways (with fees)

North-East, East – S8 express/A2 highway (with fee)

South-East, South: (A4*)/A1/A2* highways (*with fees)

South/South-West: (A4)/S5 or A4/S3/A2 ("A" highways with fees)

Drive carefully, watch around: roads are good, but many drive in a very aggressive manner! Never exceed speed limits: **"A"** – 140km/h, **"S"** – 120km/h; others outside settlements 90 km/h; in settlements – 50 km/h

How to get to “Vivaldi” hotel from the **Poznań Główny main station**:

Consider: during the day tram nr 10 from “Most Dworcowy” stop or buses 171 or 168, tram nr 12 (longer walk to the hotel)

at night: night buses 215 or 218

Beware: Each tram and bus leaves from different stop – please, watch the map carefully.

To get to the University of Life Sciences:

From the Poznań Główny main station take tram nr 11 from “Most Dworcowy” stop

There’s no direct public transport connection **from the airport** to the hotel – take a bus 159 from the airport to the city, and then bus nr 169 to the hotel. It will take ca 40 min.

Calling for taxi may be a better solution. Rather avoid picking a taxi from the front of the terminal without previous appointment, some may try to cheat you.

Warning! If you want, **we can arrange transfer from the airport for a group of a few people** (up to 6-7), twice a day on 24th March – **if interested, remember to check this option in your registration form** and put your flight number and EAT there!
